ORDER

Government on G.O.No.367, Industries and Commerce dt.5.8.87 have allocated 12.00 mgd of raw water from summer storage tank constructed by Irrigation Command area Development for supplying of water to M/s Nagarjuna fertilizers and chemicals limited and M/s Godavari Fertilizers and chemicals limited. These industries have reduced the required of water to 11.00 mgd.

2. In G.O.No.375 dt.11.9.95, Govt. have issued orders allocating 0.10 mgd of water to M/s Golden Agro Tech. Industries, Kakinada. The Engineer-in-Chief (public health) has submitted proposals to utilise the balance available water i.e., 1.90 mgd for Samalkota municipality. Accordingly administrative sanction was accorded at an estimated cost of Rs.216.20 lakhs to water supply improvement scheme with surface water from Kakinada high level canal as a source for supply of 1.90 mgd for Samalkota municipality in G.O.No.145, MA dt.18.3.96.

3. The following re-allocation for drawal of 12.00 mgd of raw water from the summer storage tank constructed by Irrigation and Command Area Development Department is ordered.

1. M/s. Nagarjuna Fertilizers & Chemicals limited	-	9.00 mgd.
2. M/s Godavari Fertilizers & chemicals limited	-	1.90 mgd
3. M/s. Golden Agro Tech. Industries	-	0.10 mgd
4. Samalkota municipality	-	1.90 mgd
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Total:	-	12.00 mgd

Government also order transfer of summer storage tank constructed by the Irrigation Command area Development serving department along with land for locating head works to the control of public healths municipal Engineering Department.

4. The minimum closure period for normal maintenance requires for 20 to 25 days and in case of special requires to the hand the closure period need 30 days.

5. The Engineer-in-Chief (public health) is therefore requested to have sufficient summer storage tank wherein drinking water is proposed to be drawn from Irrigation canals.

6. The Engineer-in-Chief (public health) is requested to take necessary action immediately.
